Job Description

The Senior Exploration Geologist position will be mostly field-oriented, requiring experience in planning and execution on generative exploration programs. A successful candidate will need to have an understanding of ore deposit models, can compile, and analyze historic information and data using general GIS skills (i.e. MapInfo/Discover), organize for and conduct field mapping, plan and execute on geochemical sampling programs, and have the ability to report and communicate activities and results to their supervisor and other staff. The field work requires the physical ability to navigate in rugged and remote terrains and the ability to work independently and/or with other staff and contractors. Additional work on drilling programs, core logging, and other project activities is likely.

The Senior Exploration Geologist will be responsible for much of the strategy, design and execution of early-stage programs, management of more junior exploration geologists, evaluation of results, and design and staging of exploration target testing. This work will require coordinating input from several seasoned senior exploration consultants and the VP Exploration. The candidate will need to be able to communicate the results of their geologic work to other technical personnel, will be responsible for regular reporting to management, conduct activities within defined budgets, and develop relevant and persuasive presentations and figures for internal and external use by the exploration group and corporate management.

Position

This is a full-time salaried position with excellent US medical benefits and requires re-location to the Black Hills area of South Dakota. Salary will be commensurate with the candidate's education and experience.
